Hospice for Lung Disease/ COPD

The patient has severe chronic lung disease as documented by A, B, C:

- A1. Disabling dyspnea at rest
- A². Poor response to bronchodilators
- ${\bf A}{\bf 3}.$ Decreased functional capacity (e.g., bed to chair existence, fatigue and cough).
 - An FEV1 <30% is objective evidence for disabling dyspnea but is not required

AND

- B. Progression of disease as evidenced by a recent history of increased visits to mD office, home or emergency room and/or hospitalizations for pulmonary infections and/or respiratory failure
- C. Documentation within the past three (3) months of i. or ii. or both:
- i. Hypoxemia at rest (pO $_2$ <55 mgHg by ABG) or oxygen saturation <88%
- ii. Hypercapnia evidenced by pCO₂>50mm Hg

Supporting evidence for hospice eligibility:

- Cor pulmonale and right heart failure secondary to pulmonary disease
 Unintentional progressive weight loss >10% over the preceding six (6) months
 - Resting tachycardia >100 bpm

In the absence of one or more of these findings, rapid decline or comorbidities may also support eligibility for hospice care.

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
