Hospice for Cancer

Patient has A, B, and C:

A. Clinical Findings of malignancy with widespread, aggressive, or progressive disease as evidenced by increasing symptoms, worsening lab values and/or evidence of metastatic disease.

B. Impaired performance status with a Palliative Performance Score*(PPS) <70%.

C. Refuses further curative therapy or continues to decline despite definitive therapy. Decline is evidenced by:

- Hypercalcemia ≥ 12 .
- Cachexia or weight loss of 5% in the preceding three months.
- Recurrent disease after surgery/ radiation/ chemotherapy
- Refusal to pursue additional curative or prolonging cancer treatment
- Signs and symptoms of advanced disease (e.g., nausea, anemia, malignant ascites or pleural effusion, etc.)

The following information will be required:

1. Tissue diagnosis of malignancy OR
 2. Reason(s) why a tissue diagnosis is not available
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In the absence of one or more of these findings, rapid decline or comorbidities may also support eligibility for hospice care.

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
